


Our offices and laboratories are located in the cities of Bogotá and Medellín.










We are a Fully **Compliant Colombian Gold Trader**











Logistic Process




NAPES PRIME

- Verified gold is received in small bars from our suppliers.
- Bars are melted into 20 kg ingots 2 cm thick for spectrometer analysis.
- Ingots are exported in raw gold batches of 80 to 100 kg to be refined in the U.S. and Europe.

CARACOLI'S PROJECT





Currently, we are working on:

- ☐ Formalization of around **200 women** artisanal miners.
- Establishing a gold purchase site in Caracolí.
- ☐ Supporting women's entrepreneurship initiatives in: *plant* nursery, jewelry and recycling.

NARIES

ASOMINO PROJECT



In 2019, Naples Prime was invited by the Antioquia Secretary of Mines to enter in a formalization process of *artisanal miners* from the *Embera Katío* indigenous community in Murrí, Antioquia.



- We contributed to the opening of a gold purchasing center.
- Currently, formalized miners obtain 90% of the gold market price instead of the 40% they used to.
- Naples Prime, Italpreziosi and the Government of Antioquia delivered 50 steel gutters to the community to increase gold productivity and avoid the use of mercury.
- Since the project started, the association (ASOMINO) has formalized more than **1,500 indigenous miners**.

Afrodescendant Communities

Timbiquí, Cauca





During this project we contributed to the formalization of around **200** artisanal miners.

- Now they are part of the local association **AURUM TIMBIQUÍ** and obtain fair prices for their gold.
- ☐ Work is being done on the formalization on assigned mining areas in order to increase production capacity.



















INÍRIDA'S PROJECT

- ☐ Currently, we are working with the **Puinave indigenous community (Caño Vocol)** to replicate formalization processes.
- ☐ We are also contributing to the technical and environmental studies for their recently approved *indigenous mining* area.
- ☐ An ARES (Special Reserve Area) assignation is currently in study by the government which will legalize gold production in the area.















Economic Benefits for Communities

- Support the set up of formal gold purchase sites where artisanal miners can get a fair price for the gold they extract. Promote cooperative practices to benefit the community.
- ✓ Help local communities receive royalties from legal gold trading to be used for social investment, such as hospital, schools, and infrastructure.
- ✓ We also support *local alternative initiatives* to mining so that communities can **diversify** their economy.







Social and Environmental Impacts



- ☐ We contribute to the use of clean gold extraction techniques and train artisanal miners in the use of mercury-free recovery systems.
- ☐ We promote **inclusion** and **cooperation** within the mining communities.










Acquisition of Mining Titles in Colombia

- **Select and promote** projects with the best economic potential.












Gold: Suárez Project

INVESTMENT REQUIRED:

- ☐ 3 million USD
- To adapt existing tunnels, adjust recovery plant, and re-activate operation.
- Projected production: 25 kg/year
















Gold: Cerro Oro Project




Copper & Gold: San Luis Project



Exploration Stage: Drilling

- Located in San Luis, Huila.
- Optimal access and security.
- ☐ **Epithermal** and Potential Porphyry Au-Cu-Mo Deposit.
- 8 targets identified. Early geological estimates 2 million Oz Au











Copper & Gold: San Luis Project



- **27 mineralized structures** already identified.
- High grade zones: Au 623 g/t, Ag 127 g/t, Cu
 4620 g/t, Mo 1615 g/t
- Average Au grade: 8 g/ton





INVESTMENT REQUIRED:

- ☐ 5 million USD
- To finish licensing process, continue exploration and value creation.
